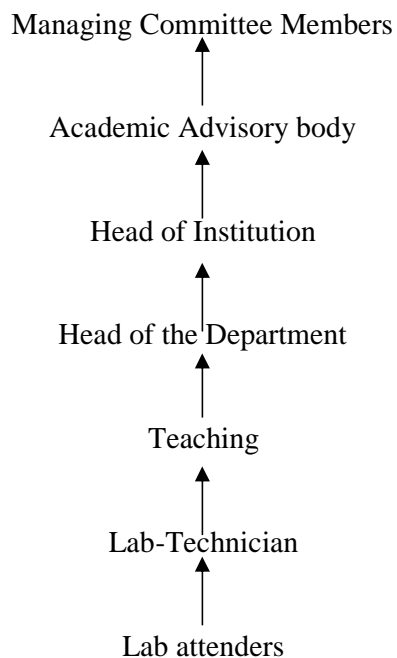

DSI signs MOU with German University

BANGALORE, Apr 23: Dayananda Sagar Institutions (DSI) has signed Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with University of Applied Sciences, Hof in Bavaria, Germany.

This agreement enables academic partnership between the two campuses and includes faculty and student exchange programmes. Possibilities of joint research were being discussed.

The DSI spread over 28 acre in the heart of India's happening city is now in its fifth decade serving the society through its large number of schools and colleges catering to over eight thousand students.

Founded by the late R Dayananda Sagar, a freedom fighter by choice and a Barrister by profession, he was also invited to serve as Minister in the erstwhile Government of Mysore, now Karnataka. After his passing away his sons Dr D Hemachandra Sagar, chairman and Dr D Premachandra Sagar, vice chairman, have taken over the responsibilities of planning and managing the growth and development of DSI.

DSI campus offers all major professional programmes like engineering, management, information technology, dentistry, pharmacy, nursing, allied health, biological sciences, education and yoga that lead to under graduate and post graduate degrees. DSI with its Wi Fi facility and 1050 systems has integrated technology inside the campus very effectively.

The DSI is counted among the five top institutes in the city and now in its silver jubilee has seen top distinctions in academics and record placements year after year. It has partnership with Central South Forestry University (CSFU) and Wuhan University in China and is offering Indian degree programmes to students of that university.

The DSI has also been invited to set up campuses in UAE in partnership with other SE Asian Nations. Partnership with Universities in UK like NEWI University of Wales and University of Abertay, Dundee and University of Dallas in the US give DSI faculty the students the opportunities to jointly work on research, academic and faculty management programmes.

The DSI has also teamed up with 29 Finnish Universities. One of the current initiatives of DSI is the setting up of Dr Chandramma Sagar Centre for Life Sciences on its campus.
